

West Region Scholarship

The administration of the WR Scholarship program is to be similar to the NCCC Scholarship program, except it is administered on a West Region basis and/or other exceptions as to be determined by the West Region Governors.

Funding is to be provided by the Scholarship Fund and sources approved by the West Region Governors.

Scholarship applications are available on the West Region Website. Follow the link to the West Region Scholarship page.

Applications are to be submitted to the West Region RE, post marked no later than July 1st. Any application received after that date will be ineligible for this year's award.

The new NCCC Application, which was used previously, is now an Electronic Application. If possible save a copy and email the copy to the WR Regional Executive or cc your application to WR Regional Executive when sending it to the NCCC Scholarship Committee. We are working with NCCC for help in making the West Region Scholarship Application simply a tag along as you send your Application to NCCC.

The West Region's Regional Executive's mailing address is found on the West Region Scholarship page along with the current email address.

Scholarship winners are to be announced at the September Governor's Meeting which is after the NCCC Scholarship winners are announced at the NCCC convention.

Eligibility:

- Restricted to the children, grandchildren or aunt/uncle of any West Region NCCC member
- A recipient of a current NCCC Scholarship would be ineligible for the West Region Scholarship.
- Must have earned above 2.5 GPA (on a 4.0 Scale) during the previous school year
- Minimum ACT score of 25 or SAT score of 600
- Applicant must have been accepted by an accredited institution of higher learning
