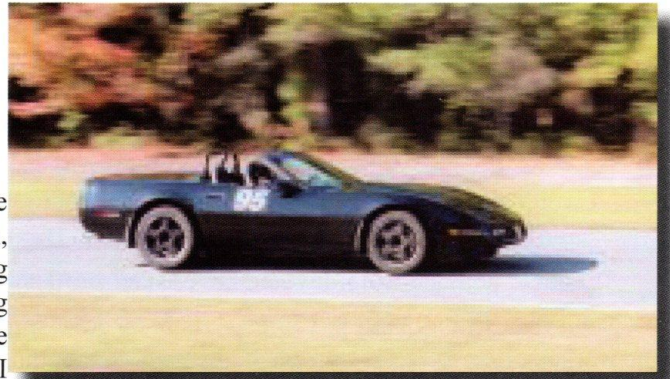
Larry Lichtenwald Muscatine CC, West Region
