

A Teleconference meeting was set up by Kathy Brisbois, WR RCD. The call started at 4:00 PM and lasted until 5:00PM. On the call were Gene Gau, WR RE; Nan Brittain, WR RMD, Linda Hommer, WR Secretary; Gary Foster, CCI; Fred Johnson, CKCA; Gary Brisbois, CCC; Tim Bailey, MACC; Shelly Miller, MECC; Barry Konken, SFCC; Frank Wietharn, TCC; Jack Bidding, GECC; Andy Jader, ACC; Jeff Bruggeman, 4 StatesCC.

We started off with a discussion of sanctions:

Frank (TCC) requested 3 sanctions to use in their 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration.

Tim (MACC) is planning a 14 event weekend in June. This is subject to club approval because the date they wanted conflicts with NCCC convention.

Jack (GECC) requested 2 sanctions for his club to use for car shows.

Gary (CCI) requested sanctions for a 21 and a 14 event weekends, one will be over Memorial Day weekend and one will be in June. They are planning to use Ankeny and Chariton as event sites.

Shelly (MECC) requested one sanction for a car show in Bennington over Labor Day Weekend.

Gene reminded everyone that we lost a club this year so we only have a total of 190 sanctions available for use. CCC is planning events over Labor Day weekend and will hopefully include High Speed events at RPM. CCC is looking for additional venues to hold events throughout the summer including something at the Air Park in Lincoln in the fall.

Kathy stated that she has not heard from Cedar Rapids at this time on whether they will host events this year or not. They usually hold events in late July.

Kathy reported that RCD's are looking to change the rulebook to limit the number of events to 5 per day and 10 per weekend (15 on holiday weekends). Most WR governors were in favor of this change. This will be part of the rulebook changes to be voted on in November, 2021.

There was a request to use blind copy on e-mail blasts so that everyone did not get bombarded with responses. Kathy will bring this to the next governors' meeting.

Kathy stated that she had been asked to present a request to change the 10 year limit on helmets to the RCD's at the next meeting. Frank stated that SCCA had a 15 year limit. Again this will be brought up at the governors' meeting.

Gene sent out West Region By-Law and Operating Rule changes to be reviewed and approved by the WR governors. Once approved they will be posted on the website.

Kathy asked if the governors found this type of meeting beneficial and with a positive response agreed to schedule quarterly Teleconference meetings. She will include an agenda with the invite to participate. The Teleconference call will be scheduled prior to the Nat'l Governors' meeting.

The call was adjourned at 5:10 PM.
